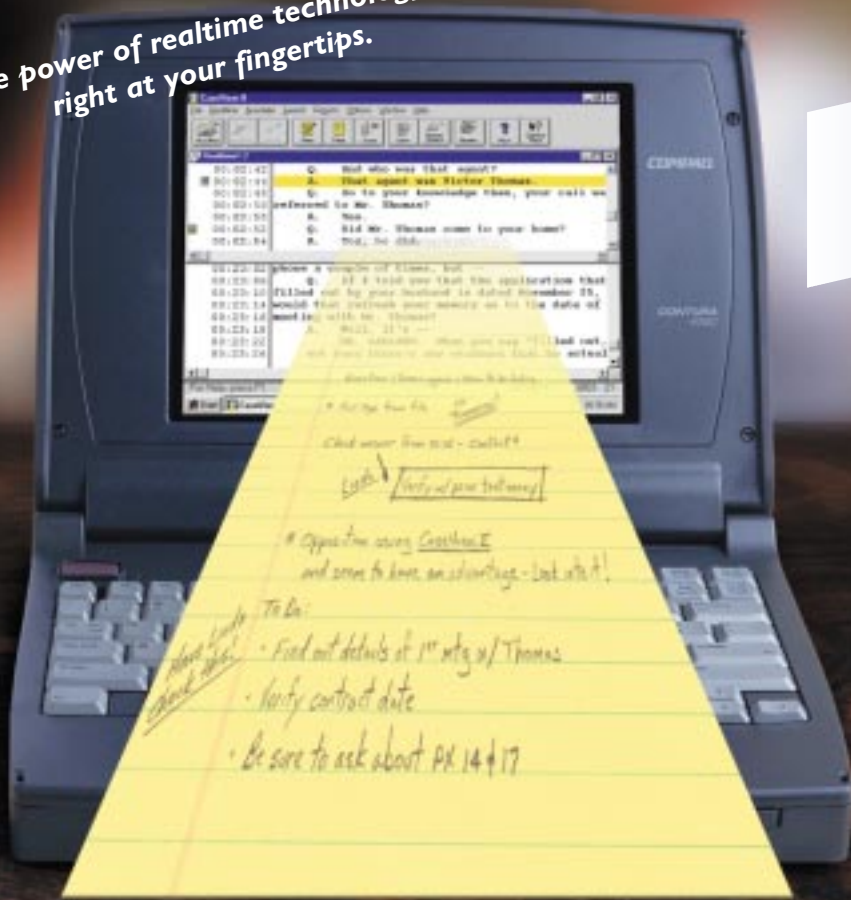

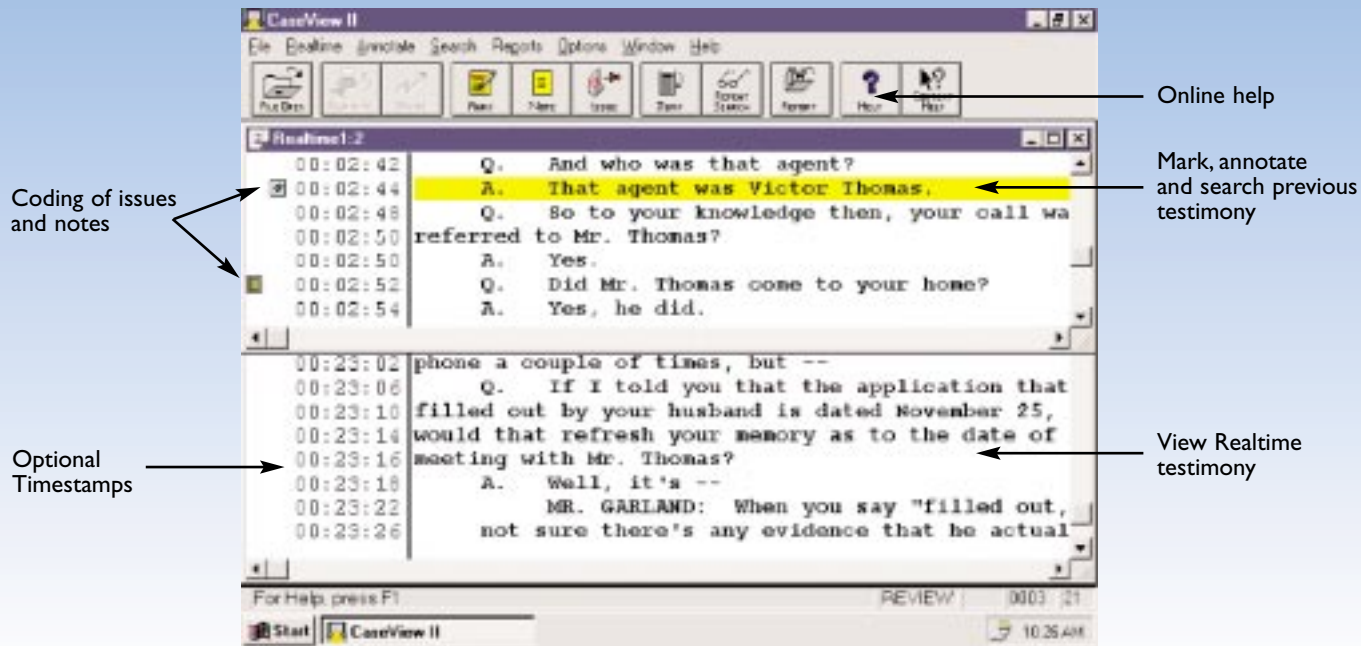


What makes CaseViewII an invaluable tool?

CaseViewII®

CaseViewII provides courtroom and deposition participants online instant access to current and past testimony. As the reporter's steno notes are being translated into text on the CAT (computer aided transcription) system, the text is instantly transmitted to one or more CaseViewII systems. CaseViewII allows you to read, scroll back, search, mark for later reference and annotate realtime and/or previous testimony.





Receiving System Requirements

4 MB RAM, Windows 3.1, 95, 98, Me, XP and one available serial port (486 or higher and 8+ MB RAM is recommended).

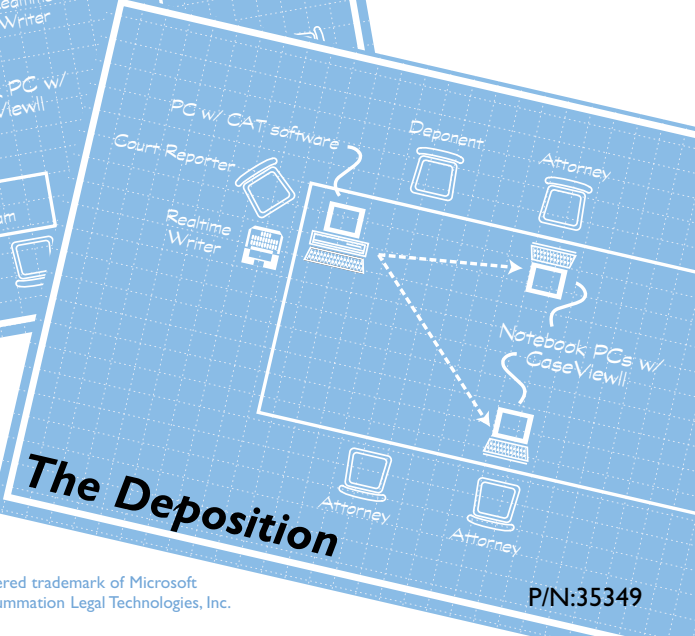
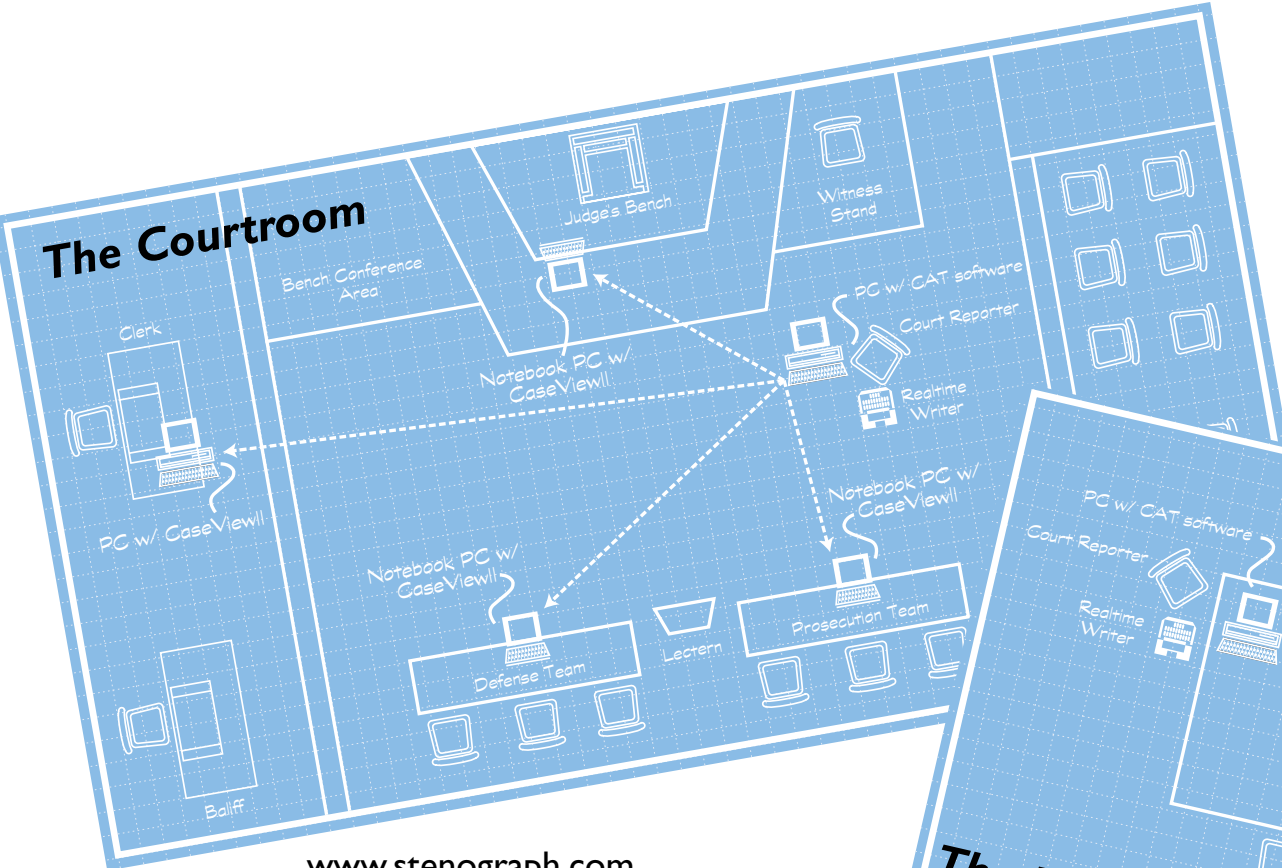
Court Reporter Requirements

Premier Power® or other Computer Aided Transcription software capable of transmitting an ASCII data stream via second serial port.

- **Mark Testimony** instantly for quick and easy review during or after the proceeding.
- **Search** testimony for previous question or answer, specific words or phrases, marked lines, time or notes, allowing full concentration on proceedings during testimony.
- **Save** realtime transcript in **CaseView format** so that review can occur after the proceeding without switching to another program. Annotations appear in context to maintain coherence.
- **Notes** are written on-screen and linked to specific testimony for later review by council or legal assistants.
- **Report Writing** of full and/or annotated text directly to a printer or file for immediate use.
- **Synchronize** the final certified transcript from the court reporter with notes, issues, and marks from the realtime transcript so that they remain attached to the appropriate testimony.
- **Issue codes** assign categories to testimony for on-screen review and/or printing.
- **Quick Issues** can be set up for the case and assigned by the touch of a key simplifying usage and improving consistency in coding.
- **Time-Stamping** optionally displays time on each line of testimony for finding time-specific segments to reference.
- **Split screens** (tile) to simultaneously view current testimony and previous testimony without having to refer to bulky printed transcripts.
- **Advanced Online Tutorial** shows more powerful and easy-to-use features.
- **Save** realtime transcript in text (**ASCII format**) for use with WordPerfect®, Word for Windows, Summation® or virtually any word processor or litigation support software.
- **Custom** character size and screen colors improve readability on notebook computers and/or large monitors used for group viewing.
- **Modems** are supported for off-site viewing of testimony by other members of the litigation team or remote participants.
- **QuickTour** online tutorial provides an overview of features and functions used most.
